HPV 2 VACCINATION – Year 9 STUDENTS

School: Blessed Hugh Farringdon Session date: Friday 21st April 2023

A team of Immunisation Nurses will be attending **Blessed Hugh Farringdon** on **Friday 21st April 2023**, to administer the second dose of the HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) vaccination to all students with a valid consent in Year 9. Please be aware that this date may be subject to change due to circumstances out of our control.

The first dose was given when your child was in Year 8 and your consent was obtained for both doses to be administered. **You do not need to complete the electronic consent form again for this vaccine.** It is important that both doses are given to provide optimum protection against the commonest causes of HPV related cancers.

The HPV vaccine used in the NHS programme is now Gardasil 9. Information on Gardasil 9 can be found by following this link <https://www.medicines.org.uk/emc/product/7330/pil>. If your child received Gardasil as dose 1, it is safe to give Gardasil 9 as dose 2 and your child will not need to repeat dose 1.

If your child has developed any allergies, medical conditions or commenced any medication since completing the Consent Form last year, please email the Immunisation Team on the address above.

Please state in the email subject heading, your child's school, full name, year group and date of birth. Also, on the day of the vaccination session, please provide a written note to your child's School Reception for the urgent attention of the Immunisation Team. Please state in the letter, your child's school, full name, year group and date of birth.
