School Colours

School colours can be awarded for 4 different areas for a minimum of 3 months. These are examples.

Leadership- Red	Service- in school (Blue)	Volunteering- out of school (Green)	Representative Achievement (Gold, Silver and Bronze)
Lead a school team. Social action campaign leader. Help lead whole school event. Raise money or raise awareness for charity over a sustained period. House and School representative. 



This must be unpaid help- 3 months MINIMUM





Rep- is your participation in extra curricular activities over a period of 3-6 months

Leadership- demonstration of organizing, supporting others etc for 3-6 months

Service- contribution and volunteering in school

For 3-6 months.

Volunteer- 1 hour minimum a week in a volunteering role, for 3-6 months

3. What have you done to achieve your school colours? Include a brief description *
