



## Intro to Pakistan

Pakistan, officially the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, is a country in South Asia. It gained independence in 1947 after the Partition of the British Indian Empire, which awarded separate statehood to its Muslim-majority regions. Pakistan shares borders with India, China, Afghanistan, and Iran. Its diverse geography includes deserts, mountains, and valleys. The capital is Islamabad, and the largest city is Karachi.



## Biryani

<u>Biryani</u> is a mixture of delicious yellow rice and either chicken or beef. The rice gets its colour from an assortment of spices and herbs, which also adds an incredible flavor. To top it off, it contains perfectly cooked lemons, tomatoes, and potatoes.

Nihari is a **rich, slow-cooked meat stew** flavoured with spices and thickened with atta, or Pakistani & Indian-style durum whole wheat flour. Pakistani versions of Nihari are typically made with beef, but Nihari can be made with lamb, goat meat, or chicken.

A Karahi is prepared in a reduced tomato and green-chilli base with ghee(butter made from the milk of a buffalo or cow), a karahi is a popular late-night meal in Pakistani cuisine, usually ordered by the kilogram or half/full karahis and consumed with naan.

## **Festivals**

Eid-al-Fitr means 'festival of the breaking of the fast'. It is one of the biggest celebrations in the Islamic calendar. Eid al-Fitr marks the end of Ramadan, a holy month where Muslims refuse food and drink between dawn and sunset. I was happy that Ramadan is over because the fast get longer and longer day by day.



Mohammed Ali Jinnah an Indian Muslim politician and the founder and first governor-general of Pakistan.
